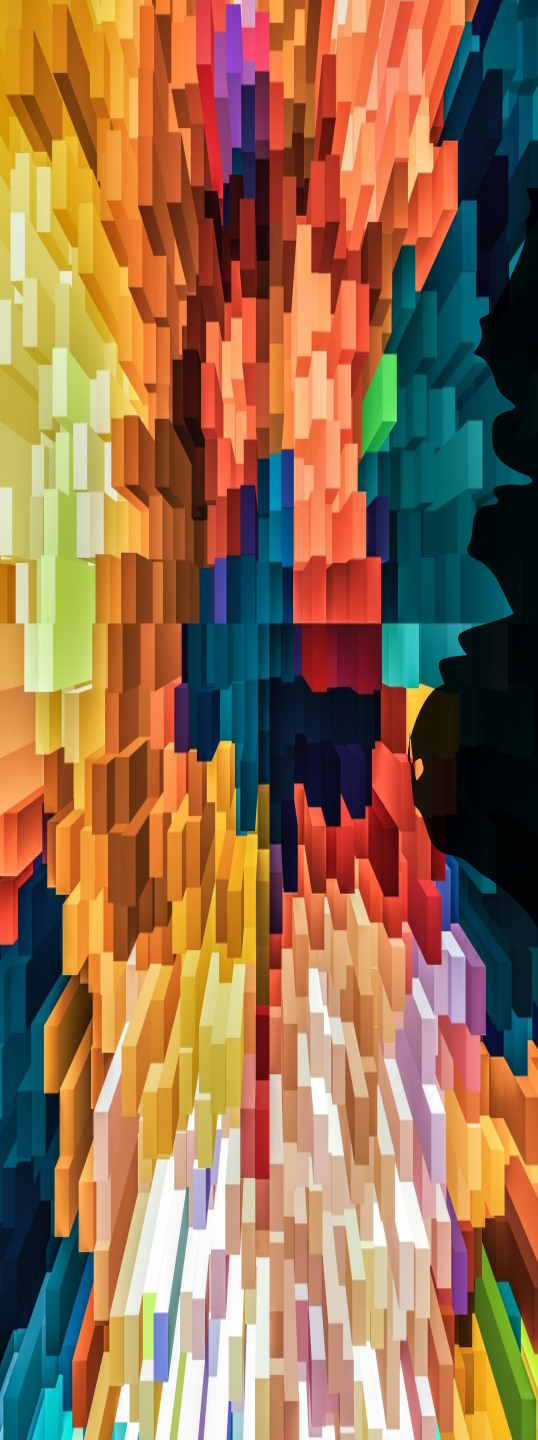

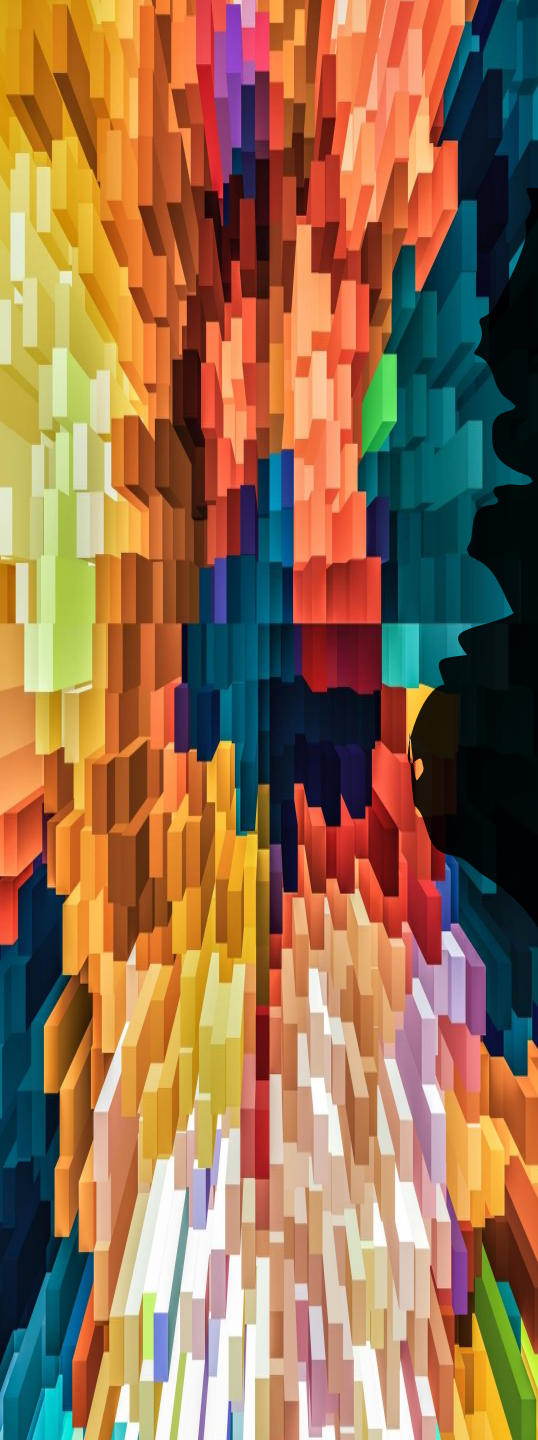
Judges 16:4-22

****She lived up to the standards of the meaning of her name.**



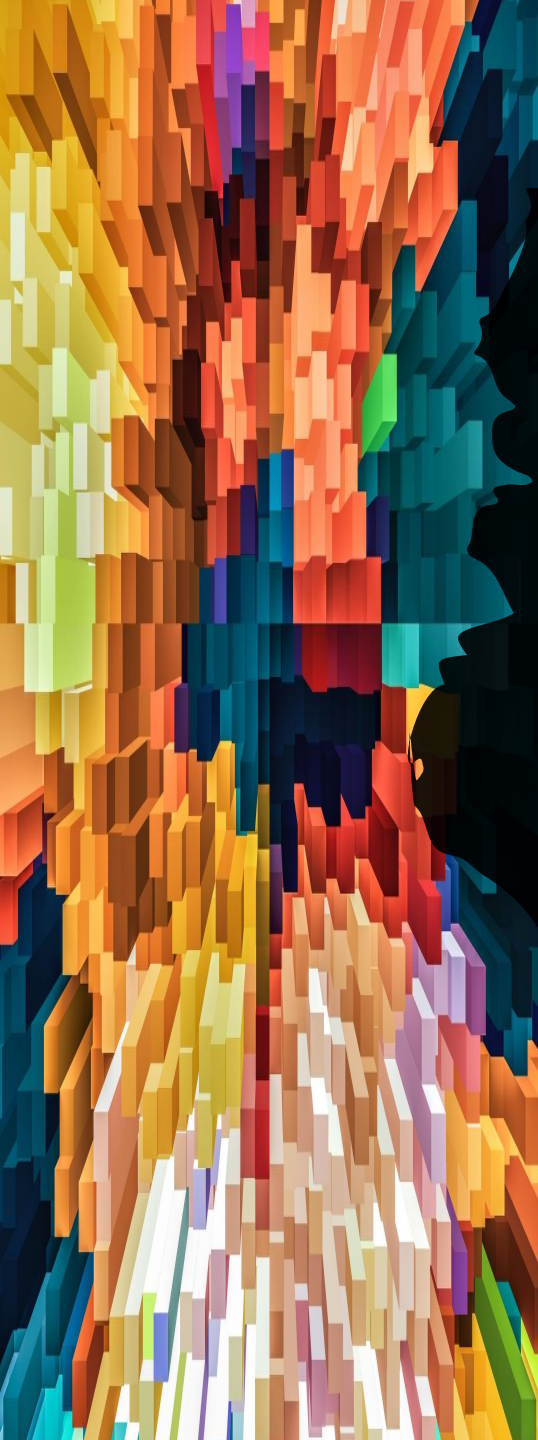
HANNAH

- Childless for many years.
- Crisis.
- Made wise decisions.
- Influenced others.
- Divine Presence.
- Godly witness.
- Prayer.

- Hebrew origin **meaning** “grace; favor.
- Good fearing woman.
- Persisted during trying times.
- Kept her promise with the Lord.
- Remembered to thank God for answered prayers.
- She was very attentive to the growth of her child even though he grew at the Temple.
- She was loving and caring.
- Blessed generation.

**1 Samuel 18:17-30; 19:1-18; 25:44;
2 Samuel 6:12-23**

- Saul's daughter
- David's wife
- Later given to Paltiel son of Laish.
- Protected David from her father's pursuit
- Mocked King David for dancing as the ark entered Jerusalem; consequently she was childless.

- Hebrew origin **meaning** "Who Is Like God?"
- She despised God when she despised her husband in her heart.
